Report on the audit of UNDP Islamic Republic of Iran Scaling Up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector - Phase 2 Round 8 (Output No. 84251) Executive Summary

The UNDP Office of Audit and Investigations (OAI), from 1 to 10 July 2014, through Moore Stephens LLP (the audit firm), conducted an audit of Scaling up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector, Phase 2 Round 8, Output No. 84251 (the Project), which is directly implemented and managed by the UNDP Country Office in the Islamic Republic of Iran (the Office). The last audit of the Office's Global Fund-related activities was conducted by OAI in 2013 and covered project expenditure from 1 January to 31 December 2012.

The audit firm conducted a financial audit to express an opinion on whether the financial statements present fairly, in all material aspects, the Project's operations. The audit covered the Project's Combined Delivery Report, which includes expenditure for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2013 and the accompanying Funds Utilization statement¹ as of 31 December 2013 as well as Statement of Assets as of 31 December 2013. The audit did not include activities and expenses incurred or undertaken at the "responsible party" level, or expenses processed and approved in locations outside of the country (such as UNDP Regional Centres and UNDP Headquarters), or where supporting documentation was not retained at the UNDP Country Office level. In addition, the audit did not cover the Statement of Cash Position as of 31 December 2013 as no separate bank account was established and maintained for the Project.

The audit was conducted under the general supervision of OAI in conformance with the *International Standards* for the *Professional Practice of Internal Auditing*.

Based on the audit report submitted by the audit firm, the results are summarized in the table below:

THE AUDIT ENGAGEMENT

Audit Objectives and Scope

The objective of the financial audit was to express an opinion on the DIM project's financial statements which include:

Expressing an opinion on whether the financial expenses incurred by the project between 1 January and 31 December 2013 and the funds utilization as at 31 December 2013 are fairly presented in accordance with UNDP accounting policies and that the expenses incurred were: (i) in conformity with the approved project budgets; (ii) for the approved purposes of the project; (iii) in compliance with the relevant regulations and rules, policies and procedures of UNDP; and (iv) supported by properly approved vouchers and other supporting documents. The Combined Delivery Report (CDR) and the accompanying Funds Utilization statement are the mandatory and official statements upon which the audit opinion should be expressed. Other forms of statement of expenses that may be prepared by a project office are not accepted.

Expressing an opinion on whether the statement of fixed assets presents fairly the balance of assets of the UNDP project as at 31 December 2013. This statement must include all assets available as at 31 December 2013 and not only those purchased in a given period. Where a DIM project does not have any assets or equipment, it will not be necessary to express such an opinion.

Expressing an opinion on whether the statement of cash held by the project presents fairly the cash and bank balance of UNDP project as at 31 December 2013. Disbursements made against a DIM project are usually financed from the regular country office bank accounts. Exceptionally, a dedicated bank account may be opened and used solely for the cash transactions of a DIM project, e.g. if the project is in a remote location. The audit firm is required to express an opinion on the Statement of Cash only where a dedicated bank account for the DIM project has been established. In cases where the cash transactions of the audited DIM project are made through the country office bank accounts, this type of opinion is not required.

The scope of the audit relates only to transactions concluded and recorded against the UNDP DIM project between 1 January and 31 December 2013. The scope of the audit did not include:

Activities and expenses incurred or undertaken at the level of "responsible parties", unless the inclusion of these expenses is specifically required in the request for proposal; and

Expenses processed and approved in locations outside the country such as UNDP Regional Centres and UNDP Headquarters and where the supporting documentation is not retained at the level of the UNDP country office.

AUDIT OPINIONS

Independent Auditor's Report to UNDP OAI - Financial Audit

Statement of Expenditure

We have audited the accompanying Combined Delivery Report (CDR) and Funds Utilization statement totalling \$ 5,285,356.30 ('the statement') of the UNDP project 84251 'Scaling Up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector Phase 2 Round 8' ('the project') for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2013. CDR expenditure totalling \$ 3,627,186.46, comprised of expenditure not processed or approved by UNDP Country Office Iran of \$ 2,618,036.19and implementing partner expenditure of \$ 1,009,150.27, was not within the scope of our audit as shown by Annex 2.

Management is responsible for the preparation of the statement for the Scaling Up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector Phase 2 Round 8 project and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a statement that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the statement based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the project's preparation of the statement in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the project's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the presentation of the statement.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Unqualified Opinion

In our opinion, the attached Statement of Expenditure presents fairly, in all material respects, the expenses of \$ 1,658,169.84 incurred by the UNDP project 'Scaling Up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector Phase 2 Round 8' for the period 1 January to 31 December 2013 in accordance with UNDP accounting policies and were i) in conformity with the approved budget; (ii) for the approved purposes of the project; (iii) in compliance with the relevant regulations and rules, policies and procedures of UNDP; and (iv) supported by properly approved vouchers and other supporting documents.

Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the project's preparation of the statement in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the project's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the presentation of the statement.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Unqualified Opinion

In our opinion, the attached Statement of Assets presents fairly, in all material respects, the balance of inventory of the UNDP project 'Scaling Up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector Phase 2 Round 8' amounting to \$4,776.11 as at 31 December 2013 in accordance with UNDP accounting policies.

Statement of Cash Position

We noted that the UNDP project 'Scaling Up HIV/AIDS Prevention Programs towards Universal Access with Increasing the Partnership of Non-Governmental Sector Phase 2 Round 8' did not have a dedicated bank account for DIM project activities subject to audit and accordingly a Statement of Cash Position was not produced.
